




About MND NSW

What is Motor Neurone Disease (MND)?

Muscle

- Progressive neurological disease
- Motor neurones degenerate
- Motor neurones activate voluntary muscles
- Also known as ALS in some countries and in the US as Lou Gehrig's Disease

Healthy Neuron

Damaged Neuron

Junctions




Types of motor neurones

Upper motor neurones (UMN)

- From the motor cortex (area of the brain)
- Connect with LMN

Loss in this area leads to

- Muscle weakness
- Spasticity
- Emotional Lability



Lower motor neurones (LMN)

- Are located in the spinal cord (anterior horn cells)
- Take messages to muscles

Loss in this area leads to

- Weakness and atrophy
- Fasciculations






Cellular Changes




